All the tractors & rails that hook to our sled should have an emergency kill switch. A lot of clubs don't require them for stock tractors. We asked everyone to put them on a few years ago. We think it is safer. Heard of a tractor puller having a heart attack while he was pulling. Thought it might be a good idea.
