*Your hitch should not be over 13 inches, above the ground.*

*This is one rule I have personally seen the importance of. Several years ago, this was never checked. I saw someone win consistently. When it was finally checked, their hitch was high. Things changed then. That is why I want the hitches checked. Our workers are good at it. When they tell you that your hitch is LOW - it is to help you be more competitive. They have a hard and dangerous job. Please be careful not to take off or back up, while they are measuring. Some complain that we don't check accurately. The hitch checker is set by measuring different tractors. They were set on cement and trailer floors. Just remember if it is off a little, everyone is measured the same way.*
